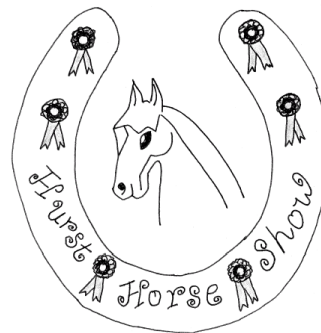

Conditions and Rules of Entry

1. The organisers reserve the right to refuse entry or cancel or alter a class or venue. **Numbers will be strictly limited. Please enter early to be assured of a place. Late entries will be taken on the day only if there is space, these entries will be £2 extra.**
2. Hard hats with three point attachment must be worn and fastened at all times when mounted. These must be PAS 015, EN1384 or ASTM F1163 standard. For long hair, hairnets must be worn.
3. For rules for the Thames and Chiltern Qualifiers please refer to www.ChilternRider.co.uk. **IT IS THE COMPETITORS RESPONSIBILITY TO ASCERTAIN THE QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS FOR ALL THE CHILTERN AND THAMES QUALIFIERS.**
4. With the exception of the Clear Round jumping, ponies may only be ridden once in any class. Ridden classes are open only to horses 4 years & over
5. The decision of the Judges and Show Committee is final.
6. If any person lodges an objection on the day of the show, such an objection should be made in writing, and a £20.00 deposit paid to the secretary within half an hour of the event. The deposit will be refunded only if the objection is sustained.
7. The landowners, organisers and officials shall not be held responsible for anything that may happen to competitors, spectators, their property, servants or animals in connection with or arising out of this event. It shall be made a condition of entry that each entrant agrees to indemnify the promoters against any claim for loss, damage or legal action.
8. Dogs must be kept on a lead and cleaned up after. Similarly, please clean up in the lorry park, this is private grazing and the owners kindly allow us to park here for the Show
9. **FREE ENTRANCE TO SHOWGROUND TO RIDERS ONLY. This show is a charity fundraiser with all profits being donated to various good causes. All entrants to the showground other than competitors will be charged a nominal entry fee, £2.50 adults, 50p children & OAP's. Bring a picnic and a haynet and stay for the day!**
